## Rigid Carcass Specification

Our superb range of Rigid Carcass cabinets are manufactured using traditional 'Dowel and Glue' construction from 18mm thick Egger or Finsa high density Melamine Faced Chipboard, with fully rebated 8mm back panels again produced in high density 8mm MFC.

The carcasses are produced using computer controlled machinery to give a consistently accurate build quality which is recognised within the industry.

All boards used are colour co-ordinated on both sides, thus eliminating the requirement for end finishes and providing a product coloured inside and out.

Where appropriate matches are available, all exposed edges are finished using PVC edging.

Base units have 150mm adjustable legs with sockets which provide end panel support.

A 52mm void is provided at the rear of base units and a 18mm void is provided at the rear of wall units to allow easy plumbing and wiring.

Base units are 560mm Deep, Wall units are 300mm Deep (excluding doors). Wall units are supplied with concealed hanging brackets and wall mounting plates with full adjustment.

All hinges are the Blum Soft Close "clip on type" with full three way adjustment.

Units can be supplied hinged RH. or LH (meaning far fewer holes in your carcass). When appropriate, please denote handing on order.

All standard drawer boxes are Blum Metabox Ivory Drawer Box with colour coordinated base and self closing runners.

Blumotion Tandembox full extension runners in either metallic grey or stainless steel are available at extra cost. All drawer boxes are factory fitted.

Glass wall units have toughened glass shelves as standard
